What is Fierce Fellows?

Fierce Fellows is a life skills program offering justice-involved individuals the opportunity to address barriers to employment and improve employment retention by providing the knowledge, skills, and attitudes that participants will need to maintain order, build strong family ties, engage/re-engage in their communities, and achieve meaningful, sustaining employment.

This is a 40-hour program, conducted over 4 or 5 weeks. Classes will be small in size, so each participant will receive focused, personal attention.



The **Fierce Fellows Reentry Program** is designed to help justice—involved individuals learn the following:

- How to recognize and cope with stress
- Strategies to promote effective problem solving and decision making
- How to set realistic short-term and long-term goals
- How to draw logical connections between education, employment and finances
- Social and life skills that can be important to facilitate self-control and reduce impulsivity (acting without thinking)
- Strategies for coping with real barriers faced by justice-involved individuals in today's society
